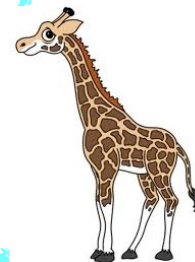




Our Days in 2A

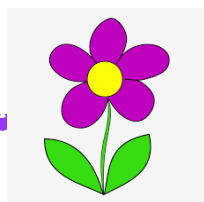
